

Potable water quality

Safety flyer 2017 - 002



Recently, several incidents have occurred where potable water delivered to offshore installations did not meet the SNS Pool standards (0.5 mg/l). This could have had a serious effect on many people's health based on :

- **the potential risk of E-coli or legionella due to : bacteria growth, algae and other micro-organisms.**

Warm weather conditions have an inducing influence on this process!

To avoid incidents please be focused on the following measurements :

- a) adhere to MOM procedure and measure the free chlorine on daily basis;
- b) when free chlorine level is under 0.4mg/l the vessel should take immediate action(s);
- c) report daily results and actions in water logbook;

Note : submitted water logbooks will be checked on weekly basis by SNS Pool.
