

# SMALL DIAMETER TUBULARS NOT SECURE IN WIRE ROPE SLINGS

## DO NOT SLING SMALL DIAMETER TUBULARS AS SINGLE TUBULARS IN WIRE ROPE SLINGS

Recently two situations have occurred within the SNS Pool, where 3 ½" tubulars were slung alone in wire rope slings.

Wire rope slings are too large to choke and grip a small diameter tubular as single lift, making this a potential dropped object.

Correct way of handling:

- Transport by basket
- Combined with other tubulars in bundle
- As per operators' Risk Assessment (e.g. soft slings / controlled lift)
